MESSAGE FROM FATHER QUENTIN

I was asked recently about the length of the Advent season and why we have 4 Sundays for the season. It made me began to think about it and look into it. Each year the Advent season is a different number of days long. A couple of years ago it was the longest it could be because Christmas fell on a Sunday. With it on Sunday we had a full week for the 4th week of Advent. This year Advent is as short as it can be because we begin the Christmas celebration, on the same day as the 4th Sunday of Advent, in the evening.

Here is a short history on the Season of Advent I found. I was surprised to find out that our patron saint influenced how we celebrate it today and that different regions had different experiences of Advent.

"The earliest evidence of this season comes from the end of the 4th century, when Gaul and Spain observed a period of preparation for the newly inaugurated Feast of Christmas. The length and emphasis of the season varied in the early Church. The council of Saragossa (380) commanded the Christian faithful to gather each day from December 17 to January 6. In 16th century Gaul, Advent lasted as long as Lent and assumed a penitential character. Because the season began on November 11 and it entailed fasting three days a week, it was known in Gaul as 'St Martin's Lent.' Rome began to celebrate the Advent liturgy only toward the middle of the sixth century. Pope St Gregory the Great (d.604) reduced the number of Advent Sundays to four....Advent starts on the Sunday closest to the Feast of St Andrew, November 30, and lasts four weeks or slightly less."
