Funeral Dinners: We served funeral dinners for Annette (Pacha) Smith and Jesse Capp this month.

Church Cleaning: Nothing to report.

Old Business:

New Kitchen Stove: We were able to trade out the kitchen stove in August to get more burners for a total cost of \$425. The cost of new stoves was \$4,200. We sold the old stove for \$3,500 to the American Legion, plus they paid us \$275 for parts we had to install it.

Rummage Sale Food Stand: We had a Food Stand during the Rummage Sale. We made \$807 to give to the church. We donated the cost of the food we used. Pies were donated.

Meat and Cheese Trays: More trays were donated for meat and cheese. Now we have 4 big ones and 12 small ones.

Shelving for Refrigerators: We needed one more shelf in the new refrigerators. The shelves have come now, so they can be put in.

New Business:

Donation to Formed: It's time to pay the annual subscription for the website Formed used by parish members. Last year we gave \$200. Jan Turney moved we pay \$200 toward the Formed subscription. Arleta Martin seconded it. Motion passed.

Oktoberfest: The Oktoberfest will be October 22nd. We need people to make German Desserts. Dolores has some recipes that can be used. We also need people to work on Friday and Saturday. Please sign up.

Soup Day: Soup Day will be November 10th. We are starting to work on the Work List. Donna Marples brought the beautiful quilt that will be raffled.

Christmas Dinner: We will have a Christmas Dinner in appreciation for all the ladies do throughout the year.
