

February Virtue of the Month - Foresight

“A wise man is cautious in everything, and in days of sin he guards against wrongdoing.” ~ Sirach 18:27

Foresight means consideration of the consequences of one’s actions; thinking ahead. This virtue looks like someone thinking, taking time to pray about a decision, writing yourself a reminder so that you are prepared, and thinking before you say something. It sounds like “I can’t do that because...”, “Dear Jesus, show me the right things to do”, “I will get things ready for tomorrow”, and “Let me think about this first.”

Let Us Pray: Dear Jesus, When we come upon situations that require serious thought, please send Your Holy Spirit to guide us, that we may always do Your holy will. Guide us with Your counsel, and give me the courage to act rightly when it is difficult.
