We are in the middle of the last year of the Eucharistic Revival. Please continue to look for opportunities to strengthen your belief in Jesus Christ present in the Blessed Sacrament. 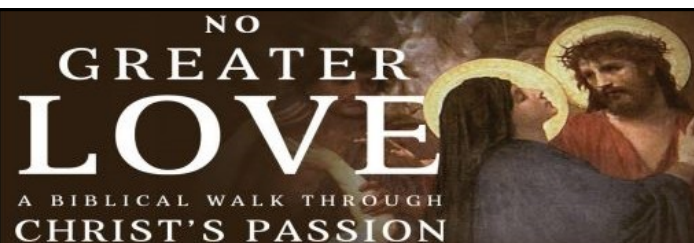
