MESSAGE FROM FATHER QUENTIN

In our Gospel today Jesus goes up to Jerusalem to the temple. Throughout the life of Jesus there are many moments when Jesus goes to visit the temple. His first visits were done with Mary and Joseph. In doing this Jesus shows us that he is one with us. He tells us in the Gospel that he understands human nature well. The temple was the place people went to get close to the presence of God in the holy of holies. We can understand why Jesus gets so frustrated by people turning the temple space into a market place. This also explains why the apostles recount the prophesy. "Zeal for your house will consume me."

There is a shift in the Gospel when the people ask Jesus for a sign to prove his authority for driving out the animals and turning over the tables. Jesus allows this to be a moment to make a prophesy about his death and resurrection. This makes it easy to see why we get this reading during the Lenten season. Lent is a season of preparation. Preparation for Holy Week and the celebration of Easter. The Gospel reading today keeps us focused on what we are preparing to celebrate.




