Report of Committees:

Funeral Dinners: We didn't serve any funeral dinners since our last meeting.

Church Cleaning: Rosie Kirkham of the church cleaning committee said the church floor has gotten dirtier than usual lately. They plan to clean it soon.

Old Business:

Memorial Day Drinks and Donuts: Donuts, orange juice and coffee were served at the cemetery on Memorial Day.

Graduation Breakfast: We served over 100 people at the Graduation Breakfast.

New Business:

Prayer in Action: The Prayer in Action group will be at our parish for five to six weeks and have asked us for some assistance with food. There could be 60-70 people here Monday through Friday. We discussed having circles make salads and desserts twice a week to help feed them. We would have one circle bring food for Monday and another circle bring food for Wednesday.
