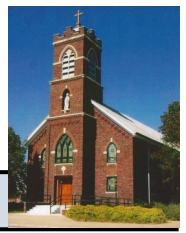

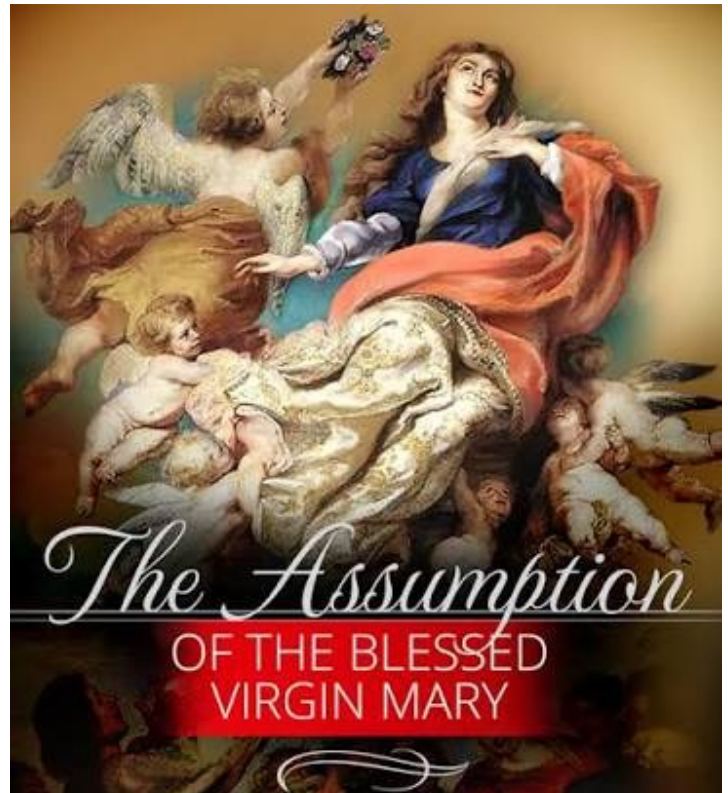

August 15th each year is a significant day of celebration in the church. Most years it is a holy day of obligation in which we gather to celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This year, since it falls on a Saturday, the obligation is lifted, but I will offer Mass that morning at 8:15am to celebrate the Assumption. The evening Mass will be the celebration of the Sunday Mass.

We might ask why celebrate the Assumption of Mary? Feasts of Mary are celebrations for the church because of her unique role in salvation history. Mary, and things pertaining to Mary, helps us to understand and know her son, Jesus Christ. The church began discussions to proclaim truths of our faith over the years. The discussions began with the Holy Trinity, then Jesus Christ, and eventually to proclamations about Mary. The truth celebrated on August 15th about Mary is "*Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory*" (defined and proclaimed by Pope Pius XII).

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary reveals to us the power of God in Jesus Christ and how that power of God can be united to our humanity. Jesus Christ in his own Ascension is different because by the power of God in him he ascends to heaven. For Mary, it is not by her own power that she goes to heaven without corruption but by the power of Christ that this happens. Not only does it speak to us of the power in Jesus Christ but also of our humanity being able to receive this power and glory. We look to Mary, assumed into heaven, to see how our humble humanity is made for God's great glory.
