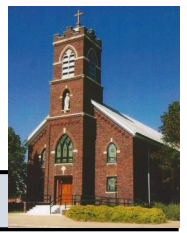

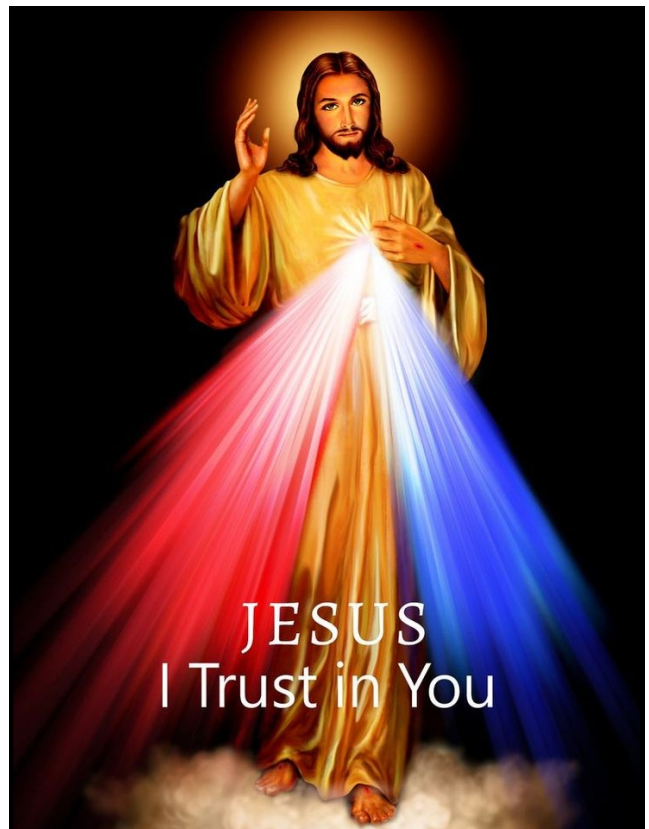

Today is a special day in the Church because it is the last day in the Octave of Easter. It is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. St. Faustina had visions of Jesus and He spoke to her about His Mercy. Below are some quotes from her diary about what he shared with her about the Divine Mercy Sunday, image, and hour. **Today I will offer confessions from 2:30-3pm. Then at 3pm we will have an hour of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, public veneration of the Divine Mercy image, and the prayers of the Divine Mercy Chaplet.** Please come and immerse yourself in the infinite Mercy of our God.

**Divine Mercy Sunday** — “This feast (Divine Mercy Sunday) emerged from the very depths of My mercy, and it is confirmed in the vast depths of My tender mercies. **Every soul believing and trusting in My mercy will obtain it.**”

**Divine Mercy Image** — “I am the King of Mercy...I desire that this image (Divine Mercy image) be displayed in public on the first Sunday after Easter. That Sunday is the Feast of Mercy. **Through the Word Incarnate, I make known the bottomless depth of My mercy.**

**Divine Mercy Hour** — “At three o’clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in my Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world. I will allow you to enter into My mortal sorrow. In this hour, **I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion.**”

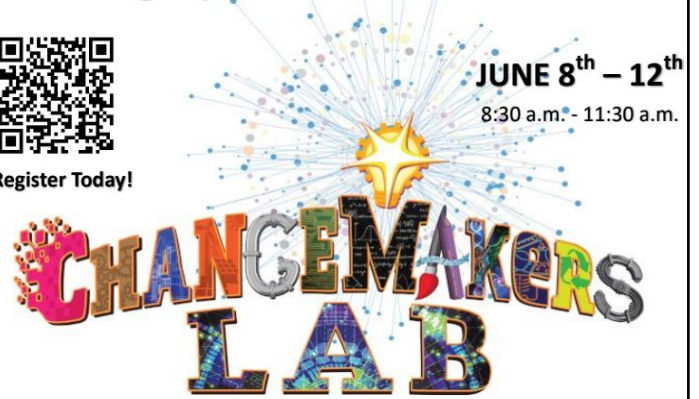
**Pinochle Club**
