The chicken and hamburger have been purchased already for the Bazaar. Prices were going up, so we ordered it early. We received thank you's for the graduation breakfast from Jodee Borgerding, Addisyn Schmitz, Grace Schroller, and Patrick Smith. We received a thank you from Mary Lou Voet for all the cards, prayers, and flowers she received while she was in Cambridge.

Report of Committees:

Funeral Dinners: We didn't have any funeral dinners to serve during the month. We will be serving one for Bob Welch on June 14th and need workers to help. Circles will be called for food.

Church Cleaning: Nothing new to report on cleaning.

Old Business:

Graduation Breakfast: Graduation Breakfast was served on May 15th. It went well and we received many thank you's for serving it.

Memorial Day Mass: Coffee, juice, and doughnuts were served at the cemetery after the Memorial Day Mass. Father used the new PA System we had purchased. He appreciated having it, so everyone could hear him.

New Business:

Father's Day Breakfast: We will be serving a Father's Day Breakfast on June 19th from 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 am. We will have a Free Will Donation for it. We will need workers on Saturday to make preparations for it. Then we will need workers Sunday morning.

Parish Bazaar: The Parish Bazaar will be Saturday, August 13th. There was discussion about raising the cost of the meal from \$10 to \$12, since costs have gone up. We have seen other places where the cost of meals had gone up.

Steam Table and Extension Cords: The old four-hole steam table is not heating like it should. We won't be able to use it for the Bazaar. Arleta moved we look in to getting a new four-hole stainless steel steam table to replace it and purchase it. We can ask the Knights of Columbus if they want to share in the cost. Jan Turney seconded it. Motion passed. We also do not have enough extension cords and lights for the Bazaar. Jean Dummermuth moved we buy 10 extension cords and any patio lights needed for the Bazaar. Glenda Stohs seconded it. Motion passed.

Meeting Adjourned: The next meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, July 11th, in the Church Hall. There will be Ladies Night afterwards. The meeting was adjourned with a Hail Mary led by Jean Dummermuth.
