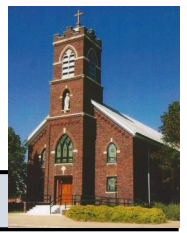

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION



This year the Corpus Christi Procession will take place at ***St. Malachy immediately following the 8:45am Mass on Sunday, June 7th.*** It will be followed by a potluck meal in the church hall. Everyone from both parishes is invited!

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. One of the most amazing things is that we are made in the image and likeness of God. It is good to begin with an understanding of the mystery of God. The catechism gives a beautiful explanation of the statement God is love.

“God's very being is love. By sending his only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange.” (CCC #221)

One of the great teachings of Saint John Paul II is the Theology of the Body. He explains that it is possible to be able to study God by looking at what God has created in us with our bodies.

“The body, in fact, and only the body, is capable of making visible what is invisible: the spiritual and the divine. It has been created to transfer into the visible reality of the world, the mystery hidden from eternity in God, and thus to be a sign of it” (TOB 19:4).

St John Paul II invites us to focus specifically on our experience within the body of communion in relationships.

“We ‘can deduce that *man became the image of God not only through his own humanity, but also through the communion of persons, which man and woman form from the very beginning. The function of the image is that of mirroring the one who is the model, of reproducing its own prototype. Man becomes an image of God not so much in the moment of solitude as in the moment of communion.*’ This ‘constitutes, perhaps, the deepest theological aspect of everything one can say about man. ... On all this, right from the beginning, the blessing of fruitfulness descended’” (TOB 9:3).
