ST. ROSE PHILIPPINE DUCHESNE FEAST DAY: NOVEMBER 18TH

Tuesday we celebrate St. Rose Philippine Duchesne. She spent a short time of her life around what is now Mound City, Kansas. Mound City is in the southeast corner of our Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. Sacred Heart church in Mound City is a shrine dedicated to this saint. Below are pictures of the stained glass in the church. They share part of the story of her life. When St. Rose came to America she began to minister to some of the early setters as depicted in the stained glass. She also opened schools in the St. Louis and St. Charles areas in Missouri, which is also depicted in the stained glass.





The second two sections of stained glass help us to reflect on the time she spent in our Archdiocese with the Native Americans at Sugar Creek Mission. In one of the stained glass with the Native Americans it looks like the Native American behind her is quietly placing a rock on her habit. That is something that they would do and come back hours later to see that the rock had not moved. This is how she got her name from them which means "woman who prays always." theleaven.org


AREA NEWS
