

This list of names is the last 10 Popes we have had in the Church.







#### May Virtue of the Month – Perseverance Saint Reflection: St. Peter the Apostle

When Peter met Jesus, he immediately left his nets to follow Him and become a "fisher of men" (Matthew 4:19). He was the first of the apostles to testify to Jesus as the Christ. Peter persevered in following Christ despite some personal weaknesses, such as doubt, fear, and impulsiveness. Most famously he denied Jesus three times during the Passion, yet after the Resurrection he affirmed his love for Christ and received the mandate to shepherd the Church as the first pope. His first letter encourages Christians to "set your hope fully upon the grace that is coming to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ"

(1 Peter 1:13).
