

MESSAGE FROM FATHER QUENTIN

The Christmas celebration and season begins this Sunday evening. The first eight days of the Christmas season are called the Christmas Octave. The Christmas Octave concludes with the celebration of Mary Mother of God on January 1st. Over the eight days we have celebrations of saints that accompany our celebration of the Lord's birth. On December 26th we celebrate St. Stephen the first martyr. On December 27th we have the feast of St. John the Baptist. On December 28th we honor the Holy Innocents, who were killed by Herod over fear of a new king being born. December 29th we honor another martyr St. Thomas Becket.

This year the Christmas season continues on through the celebration of the Epiphany of the Lord on January 7th and the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord on Monday, January 8th. Christmas this year will be 15 days long. May the joy of the Lord's birth be at the center of our focus at this time. May we continue to rejoice in the Lord all throughout the Christmas season.


