ST. MONICA AND ST. AUGUSTINE

There are times in our church calendar when we celebrate saints in relation to one another. This week is one of those times. On Wednesday we celebrate St. Monica. The very next day we celebrate her son St. Augustine. It makes sense to celebrate these saints in this way because it is through the faith of St. Monica that S.t Augustine is brought into living the faith. St. Monica gave St. Augustine life. She carried him in her whom and nurtured him as he was growing up. St. Monica also realized the importance a parent has in the faith life of their child. St. Augustine struggled as he was growing up and during the early years of his life. Even though St. Monica was a great example of faith to him his father was not. His father did not care much about faith nor encourage his son in the faith. St. Augustine gave himself over to temptations to sin. St. Monica is a great example to us of a mother, who not only tried to encourage her son in the faith, but also realized God is the one who could bring faith to her child. She begged God in prayer for many years asking for the conversion of her son.

St. Augustine gave us a great gift when he wrote about his coming to faith in his work "Confessions." St. Augustine relates in this writing how God honored the unceasing prayer of his mother St. Monica.

"Where would have been her prayers, so frequent as to be ceaseless? Nowhere except with you. But, God of mercies, would you despise the contrite and humble heart of a chaste and sober widow, liberal in almsgiving, obedient and helpful in serving your saints, letting no day pass without making an oblation at your altar, twice a day morning and evening coming to your Church with unfailing regularity, taking not part in vain gossip and old wives' chatter, but wanting to hear you in your words and speak to you in your prayers? Could you, who gave her this character, despise and repel from your assistance tears by which she sought of you, not gold and silver nor inconstant or transitory benefit, but the salvation of her son's soul?"

Later within "Confessions" St. Augustine describes his moment of conversion. All of the prayers and tears of St. Monica would bring fruit to the faith life of St. Augustine. Here is a passage that describes the answer to her prayers.

"For I felt my past to have a grip on me. It uttered wretched cries: 'How long, how long is it to be?' 'Tomorrow, Tomorrow.' 'Why not now? Why not and end to my impure life in this very hour?' As I was saying this and weeping in bitter agony of my heart, suddenly I heard a voice from a nearby house chanting as if it might be a boy or a girl (I do not know which), saying 'Pick up and read, pick up and read.'.....There I had put down the book of the Apostle when I got up. I seized it and in silence read the first passage on which my eyes lit: 'Not in riots and drunken parties, not in erotism and indecencies, not in strife and rivalry, but put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provisions for the flesh in its lusts.' Romans 13:13-14

I neither wished nor read any further. At once, with the last words of this sentence, it was as if a light of relief from all anxiety flooded my heart. All the shadows of doubt were dispelled."

This shows us the power of prayer. Let us continue to pray for one another. Parents praying for children and children praying for parents.

Wednesday, October 1 at 5:15pm - Virtus Session at St. Gregory Catholic School: Virtus is a required adult Archdiocesan program to help keep children safe. If you are a teacher whether in CCD or a school, a DRE, an employee or volunteer in any capacity, etc., you need to complete this program. Also, parents who want to help in the classroom, drive for field trips, or help with classroom parties, etc. are required to complete this program. Go to virtusonline.org to sign up. You will be directed to complete an application, questions, and consent to a background check. Children under 18 will need a parent consent form. Registration should be completed at least two days prior to the session to allow the information to be submitted to the Archdiocese and to give enough time to plan and prepare for the correct amount of materials. 


